We are proud to say that over the Christmas and New Year period calls for service were greatly reduced in comparison to the same period last year. We are currently working alongside the parish council on a programme of activities for youngsters in the village to help build relationships and reduce anti-social behaviour.

We asked: What are the priorities in your neighbourhood?

You said: Anti-social behaviour around Elmton Road shops.

We did: We have liaised with the shop owners and staff at Creswell Library to monitor times when the problems are occurring. We are also in the process of acquiring Pub/Shop Watch radios for identified premises, to allow instant and direct information to be shared at the time of any incident. Individuals found to be repeatedly causing nuisance behaviour will be issued with Acceptable Behaviour Contracts and could be banned from the premises.

You said: Establishing a dedicated Neighbourhood Watch/Residents Association.

We did: Carried out a leaflet drop to find out who would be interested in joining either scheme. There has been an initial meeting for anyone who expressed an interest and support has been offered from both the parish council and the Creswell Village Forum. Working together they are now attempting to secure sustained funding from sources including the Primary Care Trust. This will enable us to work closely with the community and share information in relation to crime and anti-social behaviour.

The team continues to hold monthly drop-in surgeries and quarterly Community Panel Meetings, where residents can help set the priority issues we will be targeting. For details of our upcoming meetings please visit our website or look out for posters around the village.
